KDOT has a project starting (weather permitting) November 3rd, 2025, on I-70 for the Flyover Bridge in Geary County. This project will include the construction of a flyover bridge and safety enhancements at the I-70/K-18 interchange for the eastbound I-70 to northbound K-18 movement. Also included is the construction of an eastbound auxiliary lane between Henry Drive (Exit 301) and K-18 (Exit 303).

Work between November 3rd and March 2026 will be restricted to KDOT project limits, and the Contractor is not allowed to impact I70/K18 traffic. Access to K-18 from Boller Road will be closed starting mid-November & local residents will need to use Whiskey Lake Road. Starting in March 2026, the traveling public can anticipate lane closures, periods of head-to-head traffic and crossovers and a reduced speed limit.

King Construction is the Prime Contractor. The project is expected to be completed no later than September 24, 2027. For ongoing updates you may also refer to our website at <https://www.kandrive.org/kandrive>.
